Brief part 2 'Tales'

'Tales' is your chance to create freely. Choose a book and create a piece in response to the book. For example you could use a cookbook, gardening book, dictionary there is no restriction.

You can use your chosen book as inspiration or it can be used as your medium. The chosen book (or an image of) will be displayed next to your piece in the exhibition.

It is proposed that *all* submissions will be shown in a CTN Exhibition during September in Alliance Francaise, Mary St. Cork. A curation process will then be used to make a selection of works for the Knitting & Stitching shows.

Criteria:

- Your piece can be made in any medium, 2D or 3D
- Your chosen book can be of any topic but your piece must be made in response to the book that is used.
- Your piece can be hung or be free standing (must be self-supporting or have a suitable support structure)
- Please bear in mind that your piece will be packed and moved several times so must be durable and easy to assemble/display.
- Due to logistical restrictions size may be taken into account in selection.

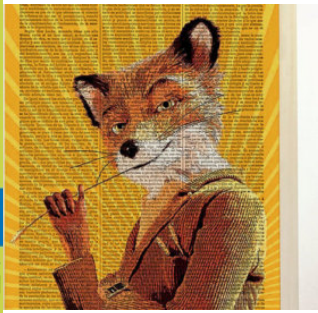
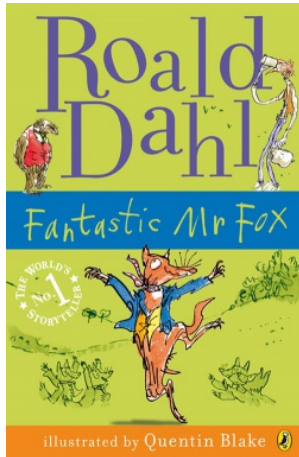
Submission requirements:

- The piece **MUST** be transportable and be submitted with a re-useable packing box that will house the piece and the book.
- The book must be included in your submission. If you have used your book as your medium please ensure that you include a photographic representation of the book.
- Name (to appear on exhibition ticket)
- Title & price if for sale.
- Medium and processes used.
- Dimensions and hanging requirements.
- Short 50-60 word statement.

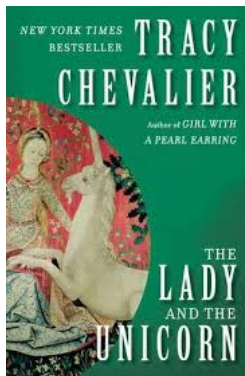
Draw inspiration from a favourite book
